

Prime Energy Drink/Energy Drinks

Recently we've had a few cases of students bringing bottles of 'Prime Hydration' to school. We have also been made aware that some students are selling these drinks to other students.

Although there are no health risks to children associated with drinking 'Prime Hydration' the drink does contain a high level of electrolytes. Electrolytes aren't recommended for children unless they are unwell or at risk of dehydration.

Another form of the drink, 'Prime Energy', contains around 200mg of caffeine for every 330ml and as a result is not recommended for children under the age of 18.

As a result, the school has taken the decision to ban all forms of the Prime drink and other energy drinks. Students should therefore not bring these to school as they will be confiscated and disposed of.
