We will explore lots of books about journeys and different places we can visit. We will recall the facts we learn to support our enquiry, whilst developing the inference skill of prediction by sharing what we think may happen next in the texts.

As author writers we will create our own sentences by independently writing sentences that include finger spaces, full stops and some of us will even starting to include capital letters at the start of our sentences.

Artists

We will learn how to junk model this term. The junk modelling area will be introduced to us and we will be guided through the process of planning, creating, reflecting on our creations and writing a sentence to tell other people about what we have made.

Philosophers

This term we will focus on the Jigsaw piece Changing Me. Identifying the names of the parts of our bodies and how we can look after our bodies by making healthy food choices. We will be learning about what the Bible says about God the creator and using the name God respectfully, whilst identifying when the name God is used in church. This will lead onto us reflecting on how we can care for our wonderful world.
