We will be learning about hats from different cultures and countries.

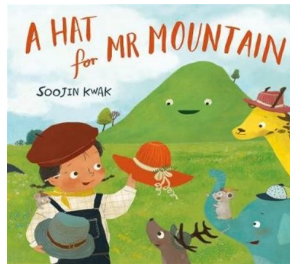
