We will be reading a book called *The Boy at the Back of the Class* and using the text to answer questions based on what we have read. We will also use the text to write an diary entry and a non-chronological report.

Children will have the chance to discuss certain chapters of the book (*The Boy at the Back of the Class*) and share their own ideas with the class.

During our daily SPAG lessons children will learn a variety of new SPAG features that they can use within their own writing.

Artists

During our class enquiry topic children will learn a variety of art techniques.
