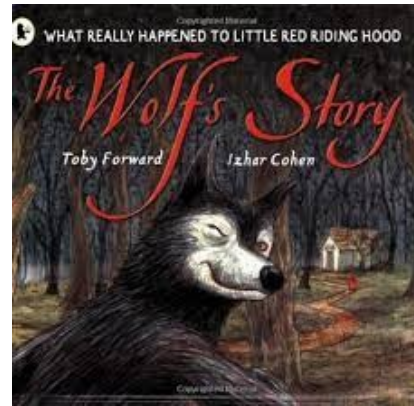


Being a Historian
